 - ▶ **Jeff Ketchel from King County IMEX (Industrial Materials Exchange):** IMEX is a free service designed to help your business find markets for your industrial by-products, surplus materials and wastes. IMEX connects waste generators with waste users, helping businesses save money while conserving energy, resources and landfill space.
 - ▶ **Michael Arbow from Ecolights Northwest / Total Reclaim:** Total Reclaim is the leading recycler of computers and electronics in the Pacific Northwest. Learn how you can dispose of fluorescent bulbs, universal wastes and electronic waste to reduce your business liability.
